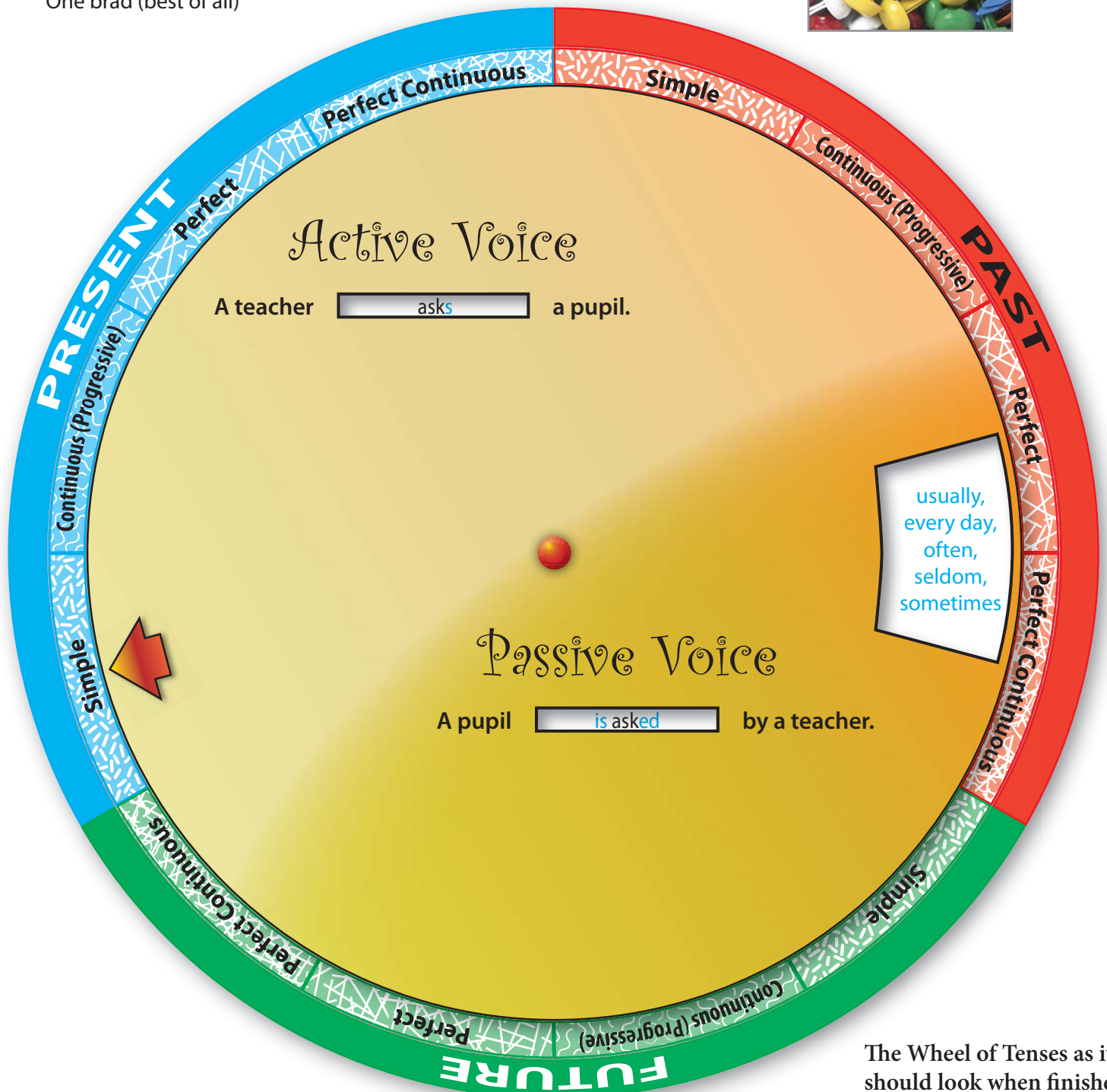
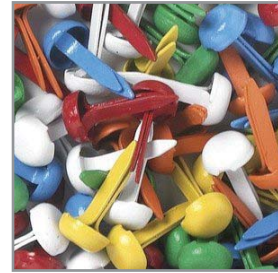


WHEEL OF TENSES

You will need:

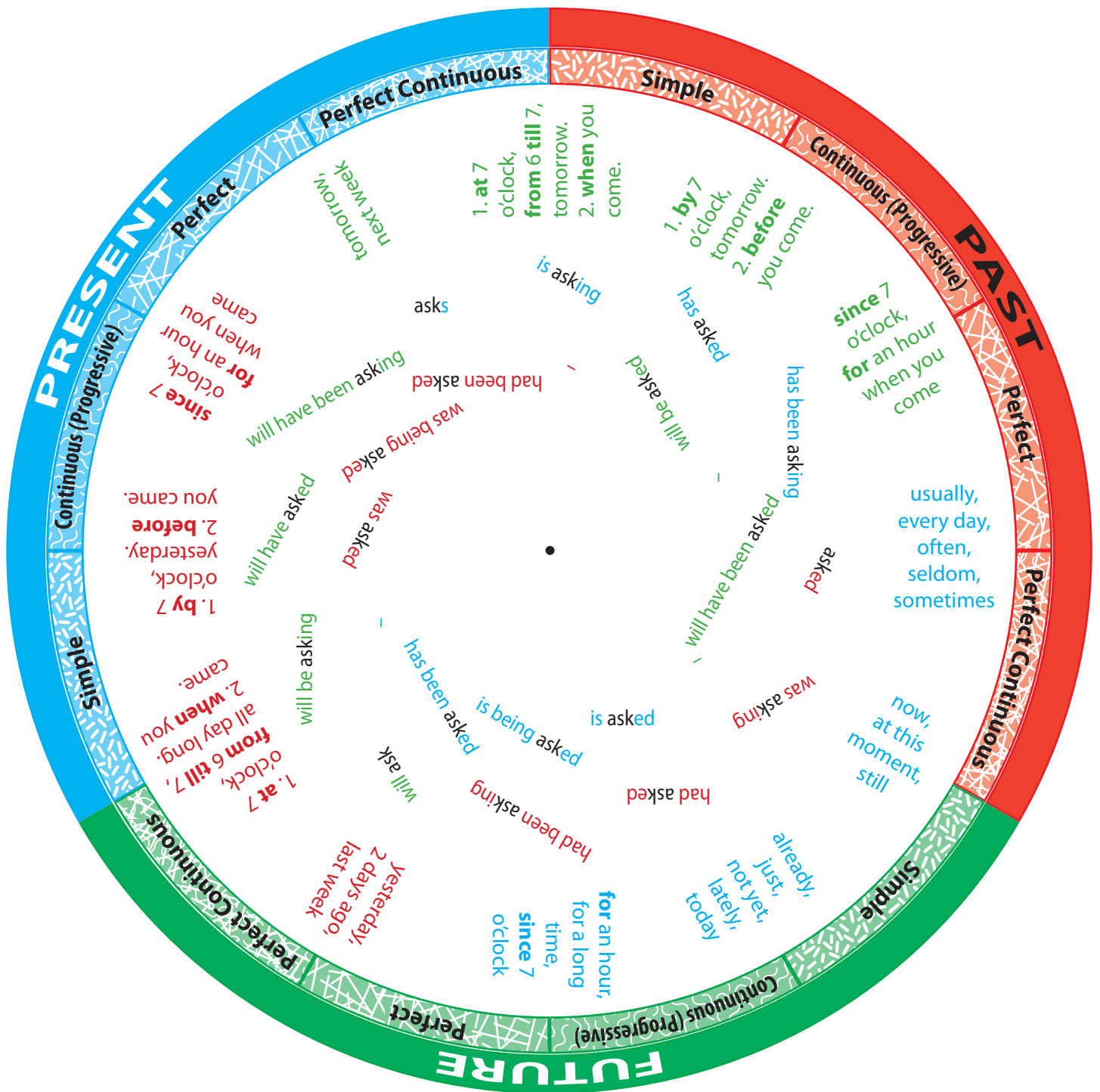
1. Pages 2 and 3 printed on heavyweight paper
or
Pages 2 and 3 printed on regular office paper and glued to the 2 pieces of cardboard
2. A glue stick (*optional*)
3. Scissors *or* a paper knife
4. An eyelet punch (*optional*)
5. One snap fastener
or
One eyelet
or
One brad (best of all)



The Wheel of Tenses as it should look when finished

BOTTOM SHEET

1. Print the page. Use common or heavy weight paper
2. Glue it to the page of thin cardboard (if you use heavy weight paper, you may skip this step).
3. Cut the Wheel out
4. Punch a hole in the center



1. Print the page. Use common or heavy weight paper
2. Glue it to the page of thin cardboard (if you use heavy weight paper, you may skip this step).
3. Cut the Wheel out
4. Cut out 3 windows (use fine scissors or paper knife)
5. Punch a hole in the center
6. Join the wheels with a snap fastener or an eyelet or a brad (best of all)
